

Parent Portal App

The Parent Portal App is designed to be a friendly and accessible user interface for parents to gain insight into the internet activity of their children.

The iboss Parent Portal App is available for both iOS and Android under the name 'iboss Parent Portal' within the Apple App Store and Google Play Store.

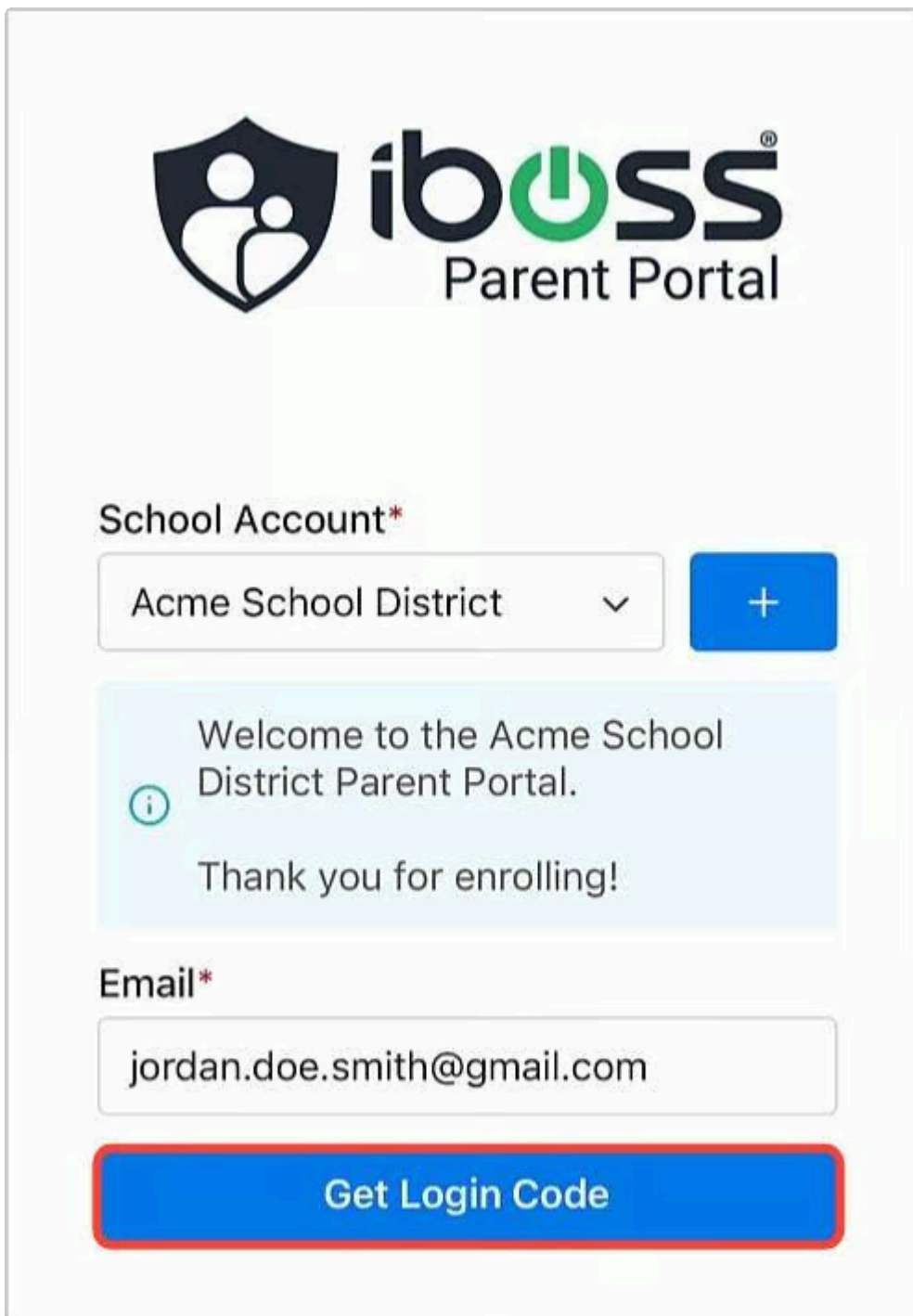
After following the initial Parent Portal setup process, parents should have received an email inviting them to the Parent Portal. This email should have contained an enrollment code within it. When parents install the Parent Portal app for the first time, the main screen will ask for the enrollment code.

Inputting the enrollment code into the app

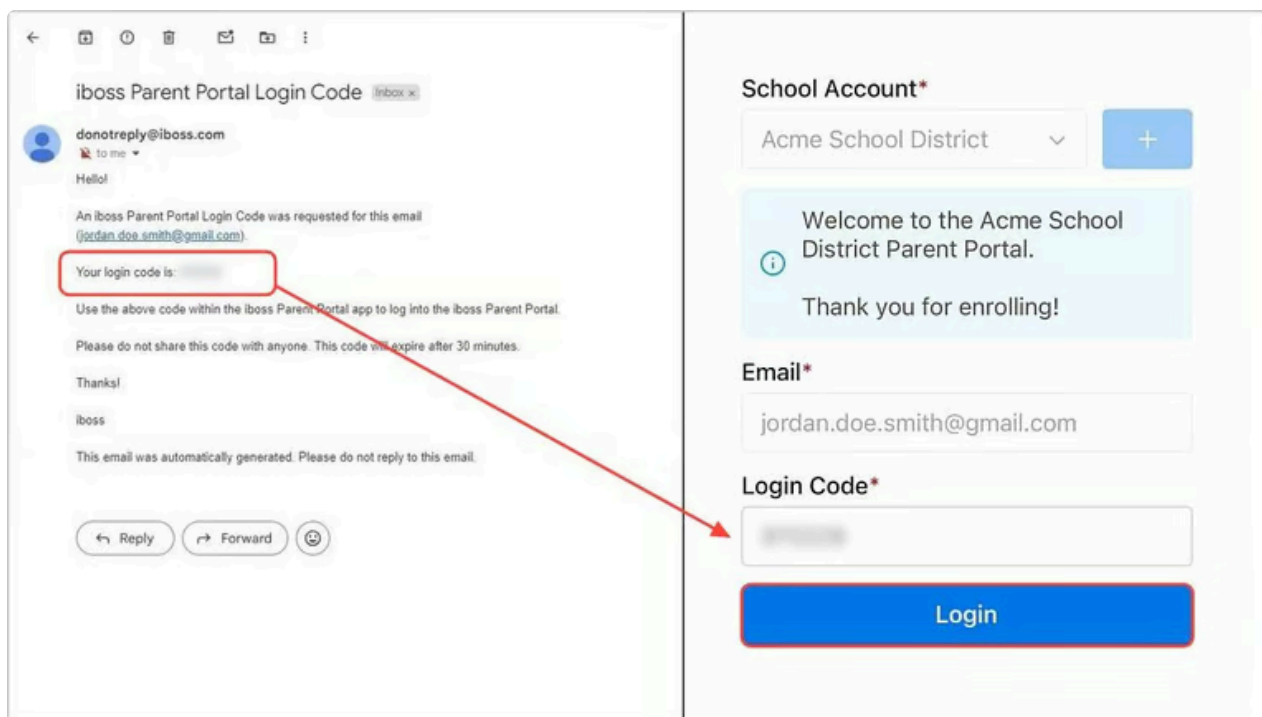
After submitting the enrollment code, the school's name will be shown to the parent and the page will ask for their email address. After inputting their email and hitting 'Get Login Code' another email will be sent to them with a one-time code to use to login. This is also where parents will see the Login Message

Parent Portal Features

Key features include detailed browsing records, activity summaries, and internet access controls, all presented through a user-friendly interface.

Summary

The summary is the main landing page for the Parent Portal. It encompasses high level information about the selected students' internet activity. This includes a list of search terms, frequently visited sites, and any interactions with mental health resources. It also highlights visits to sites that might pose a risk or detract from productivity.

Type	Description
Top Keywords Searched	Top words searched, usually via search engines. Dangerous keywords will stand out here.
Top Sites Visited	The most viewed sites for this student across the time range.
Top Mental Health Sites	Similar to Top Sites Visited, but only sites focused on mental health that have been visited. This includes categories like Suicide and Drugs
Top High-Risk Sites Visited	Similar to Top Sites Visited, but only high-risk sites that have been visited. This includes categories like Adult Content and Nudity
Top Threats to Harm Sites	Similar to Top Sites Visited, but only sites related to harm. This includes categories like Weapons and Violence
Top Productivity Loss Sites	Similar to Top Sites Visited, but only sites focused on productivity loss that have been visited. This includes categories such as, Video Streaming, Social Media, and Games

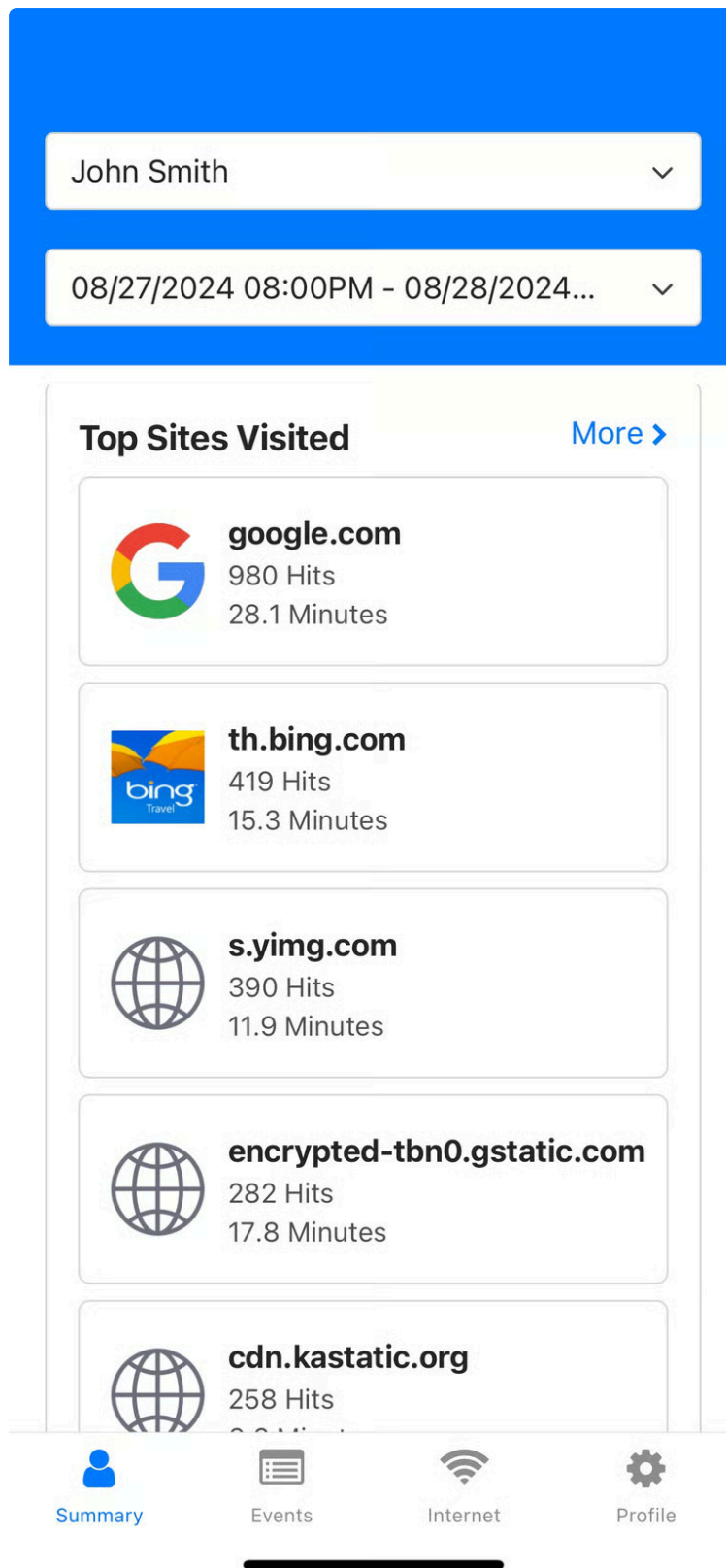

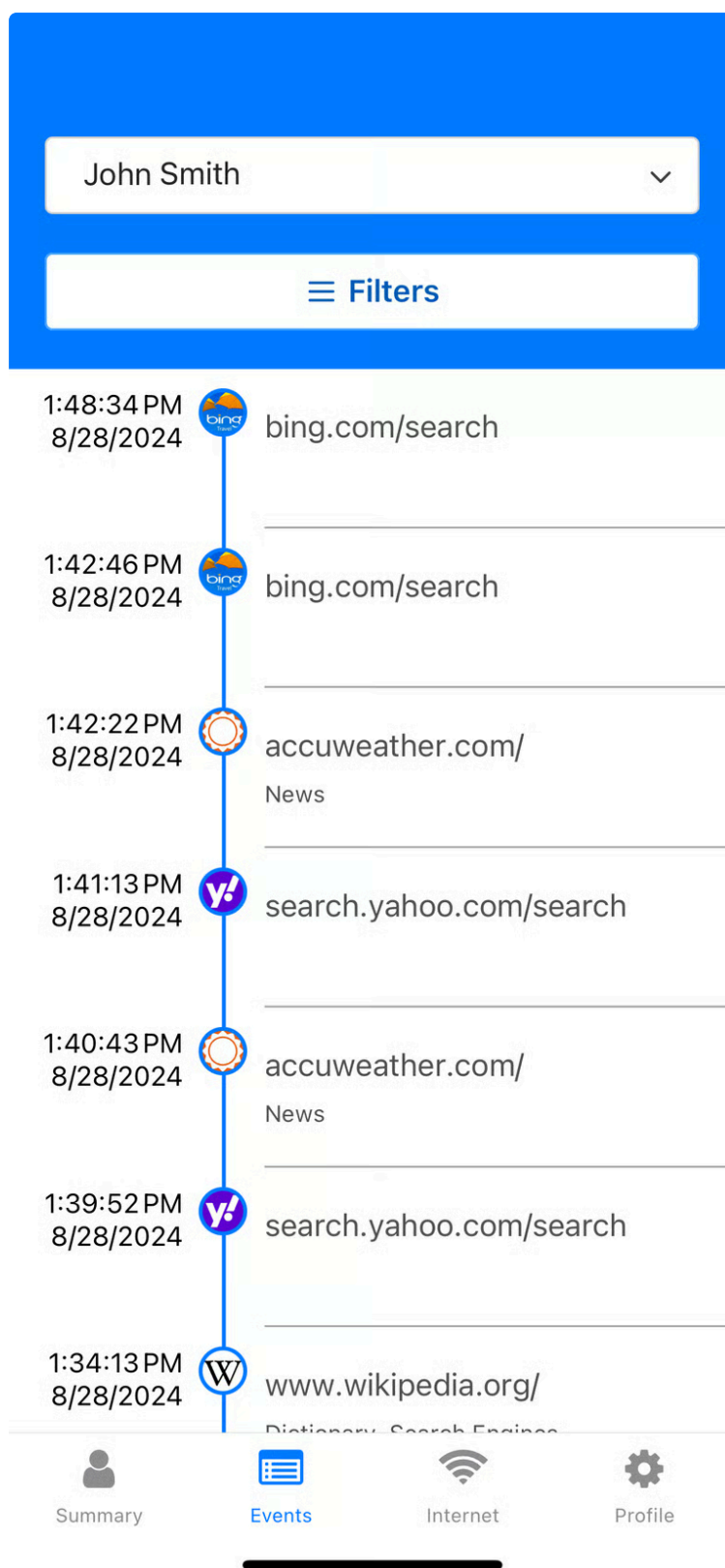

Events

The events section is a more detailed timeline of what the student has been doing. This timeline displays every site the student has gone too in chronological order. This page also provides filters to narrow down searches by date and by sire. Blocked searches will stand out here.



Events List

Internet

The internet section gives parents the ability to manage their child's internet access. At the top of the page, the current internet access status is displayed, showing either **Active** (green) or **Disabled** (red).

This section is divided into two tabs: **Schedules** and **Controls**.

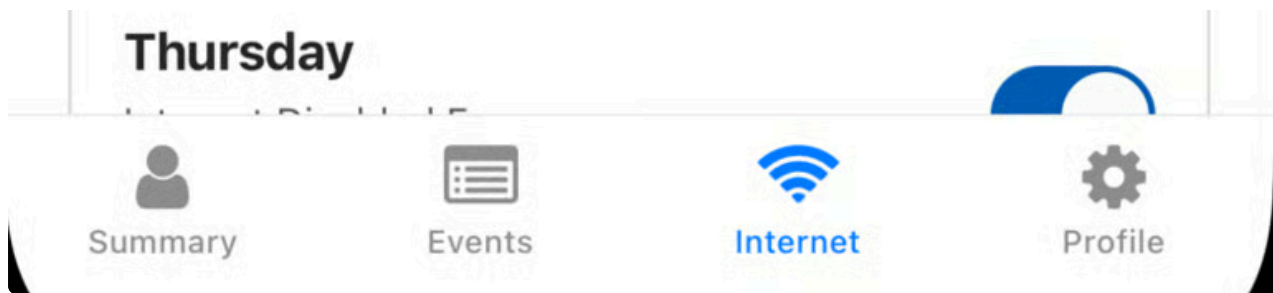

Schedules

The Schedules tab allows parents to set timeframes where internet access will be disabled. If the parent creates a schedule that would disable internet during school hours, it is ignored as to not interfere with learning.

New schedules can be added by tapping the **Add Schedule** button. When creating a schedule, parents can configure:

- **Start Time** - When internet access should be disabled
- **End Time** - When internet access should be restored, or check **Until End of Day** to disable for the remainder of the day
- **Days of Week** - Which days the schedule should apply (Monday through Sunday)



This schedule controls when internet access will be **DISABLED**.

Each schedule displays the day of the week, the time range when internet is disabled, and a toggle to quickly enable or disable that schedule.

 Internet schedules only control the times which internet will be DISABLED. All other times of the day, internet will be ENABLED by default.

Controls

The Controls tab gives parents the ability to block specific categories of websites and individual domains. These blocking rules apply when the student's internet is active—outside of school hours and when an internet disabled schedule is not in effect.

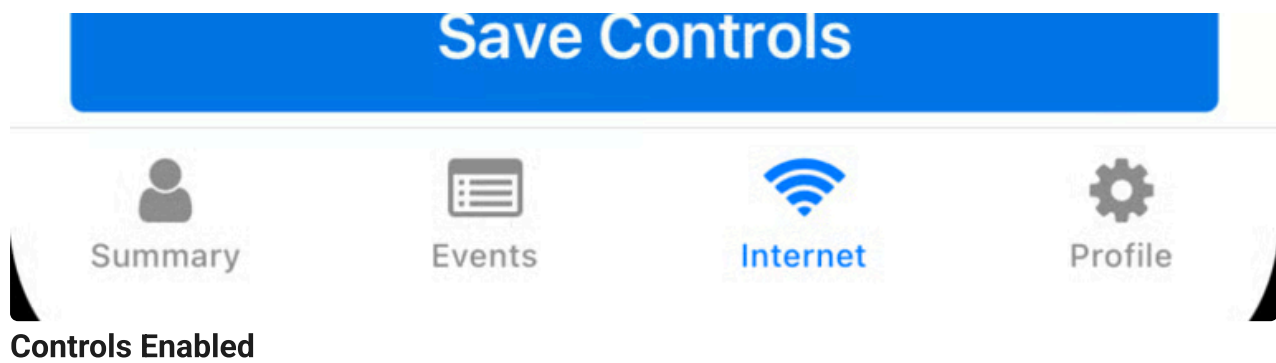

At the top of the Controls section is a toggle to enable or disable the blocking rules. When disabled, no category or site blocking will be applied. When enabled, the configured blocking rules will take effect during non-school hours.

Blocked Categories

Parents can select which categories of websites to block by tapping the **Select** button next to Blocked Categories. This opens a category selection screen where categories can be toggled on or off by tapping them.

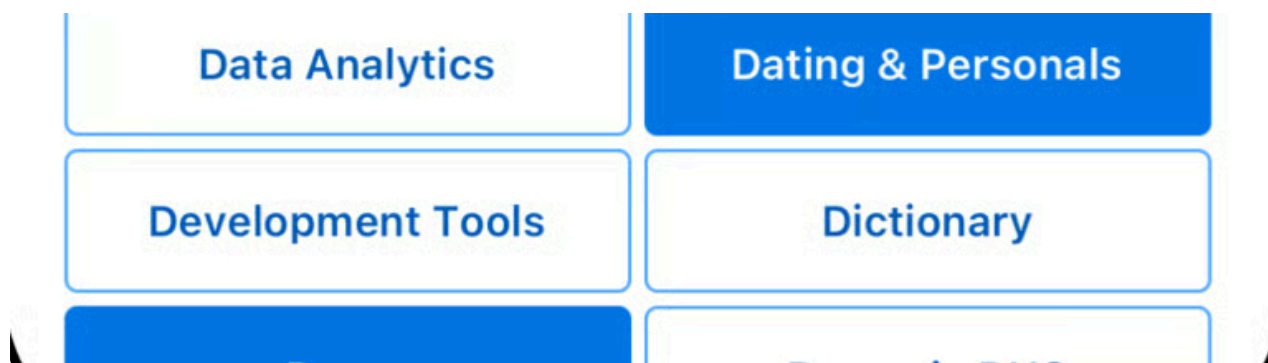
- **Blue** categories are blocked
- **White** categories are allowed

The number of currently blocked categories is displayed on the Controls tab.

Tap categories to block. Blue = blocked, white = allowed.

Blocked Sites

In addition to category-based blocking, parents can block up to 50 specific domains. To add a blocked site:

1. Enter the domain in the text field (e.g., tiktok.com)
2. Tap **Add**

Domains are automatically normalized, removing any http/https prefixes and trailing slashes. To remove a blocked domain, tap the **X** icon next to it.

Saving Changes

After configuring the Controls settings, tap **Save Controls** to apply the changes. The page displays who last modified the controls, allowing multiple parents linked to the same student to see each other's changes.

 Blocking rules set in Controls only apply when internet access is active. They do not apply during school hours or during times when an internet disabled schedule is in effect.

Profile

The profile section is very simple and straightforward. This is where parents will see the defined Profile Message. This is also where parents can log out of the app, see the terms and conditions and see which version of the app they are running.
